### ONLINE STEPS TO JOIN - ZOOM

To ensure a pleasant experience with your first Zoom Meeting, we highly encourage individuals to download and install the Zoom Application beforehand.

To download and install the Zoom Application:

Go to <https://zoom.us/download> and from the Download Center, click on the Download button under “Zoom Client For Meetings”.

This application will automatically download when you start your first Zoom Meeting.

Once the download is complete, proceed with installing the Zoom application onto your computer.

Enter your 9 or 10 digit Meeting ID and Your Name. 4. Click Join.
- #### Quick Tips for Using Zoom

- If you are using an external camera and/or microphone be sure to plug them in before opening the Zoom application. We recommend using a headset if possible.
- Only 1 microphone and speaker system should be active per physical location. Otherwise the 2 systems may cause a loud screeching sound.
- Be sure to mute yourself when you are not speaking.
- Use the Chat feature to ask questions without interrupting the speaker.
- You cannot record unless you are the meeting host, or the meeting host allows you permission to record.
- Zoom sessions without a Zoom Pro user signed in will be limited to 45 minutes

### OPENING STATEMENT & PRAYER – PASTOR RUSS

**2 Chronicles 7:13-14 (GN)** <sup>13</sup> Whenever I hold back the rain or send locusts to eat up the crops or send an epidemic on my people, <sup>14</sup> if they pray to me and repent and turn away from the evil they have been doing, then I will hear them in heaven, forgive their sins, and make their land prosperous again.

Note this passage ends with God’s promise to “heal their land,” the miracle we need today. What precedes this blessing?

- We must **humble** ourselves, admitting that we need what only God can give us. Then we *pray*—the Hebrew word describes collective prayer for divine favor.
- To “**seek my face**” points to a personal, passionate engagement with the Lord.
- To “**turn from their wicked ways**” is to repent of sins that the first three acts have revealed.
